


Extra grammar 2 • The passive: Past simple

My favourite museum in London

I'm spending my holiday in London this summer. Because I love history and learning about the past, I've visited the British Museum a lot. If you're into history, you'll love this place. It's got things from all over the world which all tell interesting stories. Here are some of my favourites:

The Portland Vase

This ancient Roman vase was discovered in the 16th century near Rome. It's really beautiful and it was made of dark blue and white **glass**. In 1845, it was broken into 190 pieces by a visitor to the museum! Fortunately, the vase was repaired soon afterwards.

The Rosetta Stone

The Rosetta Stone is one of the most famous items in the museum. It was brought here from Egypt in 1802. A message from an ancient king was inscribed into the **stone** in three different languages, including ancient Greek and Egyptian hieroglyphs. The ancient Greek language was known by experts, but they didn't understand how to read Egyptian hieroglyphs. So the stone was used to learn the 'alphabet'.

Egyptian mummies

When an important man or woman died in ancient Egypt, the body was wrapped in **linen** and it was put in a decorated sarcophagus. In the 19th century, lots of the mummies were found by British explorers and they were collected for the museum. It now has about 120 human mummies and also mummies of animals such as snakes, dogs and even a four-metre crocodile.

**Samurai armour**

My favourite **artefacts** in the museum are from Japan. I love the suits of samurai armour. They are really beautiful. They were made of **metal** and **leather** hundreds of years ago. They probably weren't worn often because they are in perfect condition.

Organi di governo del comune e della provincia

Art. 39 (¹)

Presidenza dei consigli comunali e provinciali

1. I consigli provinciali e i consigli comunali dei comuni con popolazione superiore a 15.000 abitanti sono presieduti da un presidente eletto tra i consiglieri nella prima seduta del consiglio. Al presidente del consiglio sono attribuiti, tra gli altri, i poteri di convocazione e direzione dei lavori e delle attività del consiglio. Quando lo statuto non dispone diversamente, le funzioni vicarie di presidente del consiglio sono esercitate dal consigliere anziano individuato secondo le modalità di cui all'articolo 40. Nei comuni con popolazione sino a 15.000 abitanti lo statuto può prevedere la figura del presidente del consiglio.

2. Il presidente del consiglio comunale o provinciale è tenuto a riunire il consiglio, in un termine non superiore ai venti giorni, quando lo richiedano un quinto dei consiglieri, o il sindaco o il presidente della provincia, inserendo all'ordine del giorno le questioni richieste.
