

Peter Higgs is a famous physicist who won the Nobel Prize. Last week, he died at the age of 94.

People know Higgs for his **theory** which suggests the existence of the Higgs boson, often called the 'God particle'.

According to Higgs this particle gives **mass** to other particles and plays an important role in creating the universe. Higgs developed this theory in the 1960s, and decades later, scientists at CERN's Large Hadron Collider in Switzerland **proved** it.

Although people normally used the term 'God particle', Higgs was a modest person and he focused on science. Finding the Higgs boson was a big discovery which helped scientists understand particles and forces in the universe.

Difficult words: **theory** (ideas which explain something), **mass** (many particles together which form one body), **prove** (to show that something is true).


